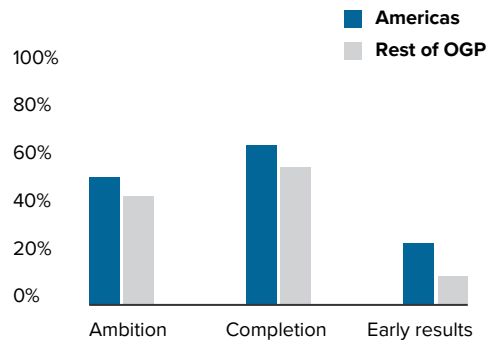

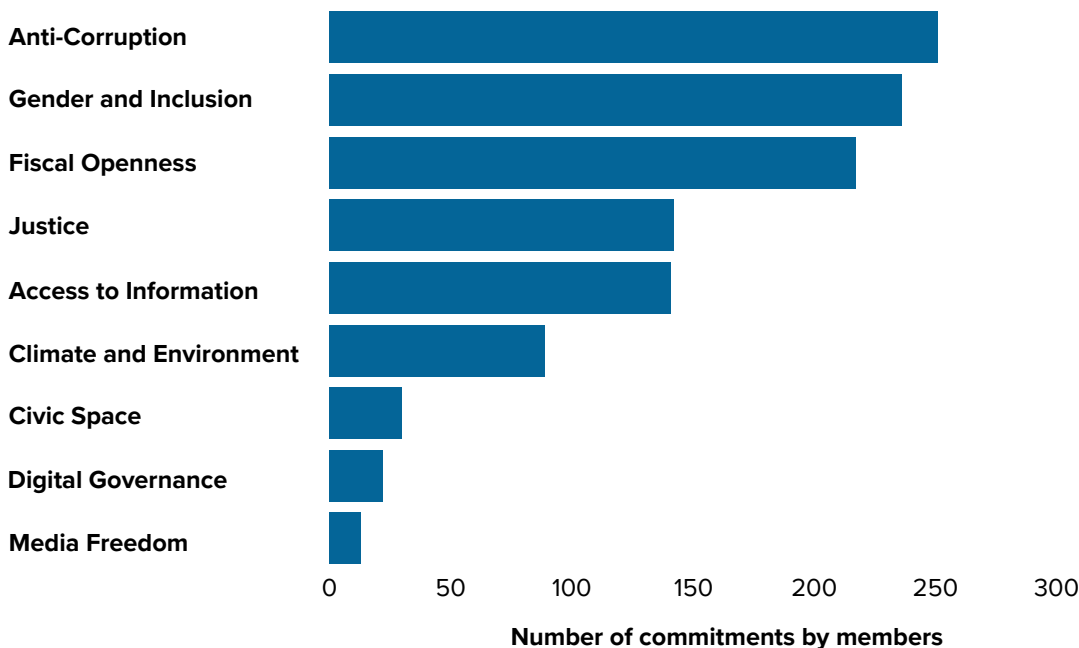
COMMITMENT PERFORMANCE

OVERVIEW OF THEMATIC AREAS

OGP members in the Americas have made hundreds of commitments related to topics covered in the Open Gov Challenge. Below are the most popular thematic areas.



About half of all OGP local members are in the Americas.

Altogether, 38 local members in the region have made a total of nearly **200 commitments**. These commitments cover a wide variety of policy areas like public participation, open data, and public service delivery.

* The Independent Reporting Mechanism (IRM) is OGP's accountability arm and the main means of tracking progress in participating countries.
