



#### **OVERVIEW OF THEMATIC AREAS**

OGP members in the Americas have made hundreds of commitments related to topics covered in the Open Gov Challenge. Below are the most popular thematic areas.





**About half** of all OGP local members are in the Americas.

Altogether, 38 local members in the region have made a total of nearly **200 commitments**. These commitments cover a wide variety of policy areas like public participation, open data, and public service delivery.
